



A Small Business Mentoring, Boot Camp and Business Plan Competition

We are accepting competitive applications to our Startup and Grow Martinsville-Henry County Programs from <u>coachable</u> entrepreneurs.

On an annual basis, the **Chamber's Partnership for Economic Growth (C-PEG)** operates a business plan competition which includes a <u>requirement</u> to participate in a **boot camp** to help you evaluate your **entrepreneurial mindset** readiness, **write a business plan** and **present a business pitch** to compete for funding and receive ongoing mentoring.

Since the program launched in 2015, over 294 entrepreneurs have completed the boot camp sessions, and 58 businesses have collectively been awarded \$459,724 in cash and in-kind support. Small businesses have created over \$4,356,000 in new capital investment and created 240+ jobs.

Due to limited space, the application process is **competitive**.

Eligible types of businesses include for legal, profit businesses with a physical business location in Martinsville or Henry County, Virginia, with the exception of pyramid or multi level marketing companies, which will contribute to the local tax base and preference is to applicants whose business venture will also create jobs in Martinsville or Henry County. Preference may be given to small batch production companies, technology, healthcare and construction trade businesses.
