We are accepting competitive applications to our Startup and Grow Martinsville-Henry County Programs from <u>coachable</u> entrepreneurs.

On an annual basis, the **Chamber's Partnership for Economic Growth (C-PEG)** operates a business plan competition which includes a <u>requirement</u> to participate in a **boot camp** to help you evaluate your **entrepreneurial mindset** readiness, **write a business plan** and **present a business pitch** to compete for funding and receive ongoing mentoring.

Since the program launched in 2015, over 314 entrepreneurs have completed the boot camp sessions, and 70 businesses have collectively been awarded \$571,724 in cash and in-kind support. Small businesses have created over \$5,000,000 in new capital investment and created 270+ jobs.

Due to limited space, the application process is competitive.

Understanding of Guidelines Agreement

Startup MHC – Fall Session 2023

*Deadline to Apply for Startup MHC or Grow MHC is <u>12 PM</u> Local Time, Friday, September 8, 2023.

Directions: Read each point, then initial that you have read and comprehended each item. At the end, please print your name and provide signature indicating that you understand these guidelines and choose to apply and, if selected, participate in Startup MHC or **Grow** Martinsville-Henry County, Virginia. If there are multiple business owners, <u>each</u> individual is required to complete this form. This program is for <u>coachable entrepreneurs only</u>. All awardees must provide financial data for review each month.

• I understand that attendance in <u>all 8</u> sessions for Startup MHC or <u>all 4</u> sessions for Grow MHC is mandatory to be eligible for the awards; and I have read the Attendance Policy, which states:

Participants are required to attend **all** sessions. The only excused absences that can be made up include documented sickness and immediate family emergency or death and work-related activity. Participants with an excused absence must meet with the instructor to make up any missed work before the next scheduled class. Participants with an unexcused absence will be ineligible to compete for grant funds at the Pitch Event. Even with an excused absence, failure to meet with the instructor and/or to make up missed work before the next scheduled class also may result in participant's ineligibility to compete for grant funds at Pitch Event.

 Eligible types of businesses include for legal, profit businesses with a physical business location in Martinsville or Henry County, Virginia, with the exception of pyramid or multi level marketing companies, which will contribute to the local tax base and preference is to applicants whose business venture will also create jobs in Martinsville or Henry County. Preference may be given to small batch production companies, technology, healthcare, construction, added-value agriculture business products trade businesses.

• To be eligible to compete for any award, I must (1) complete and submit a business plan for Startup by 12:00PM local time on Tuesday, November 21, 2023, (2) participate in the Pitch Event: Startup - Thursday, December 5, 2023, (3) expand my business in Martinsville or Henry County, Virginia by September 30, 2024, and expend grant award funds within 6 months of grant notification.

• I certify that my business is a legal operation, is a for profit business and is <u>not</u> a multi level or pyramid business model, nor is it a unit of government. _____

Prior to the pitch event, I understand that I must meet with the local Longwood University Small Business Development Center staff to review my business concept and sign off on my <u>2 year</u> financial projections.

- To meet C-PEG funder's required funding guidelines, I understand that award winners will be <u>required</u> to provide monthly profit and loss statements for 12 months and document business expansion through a signed performance agreement for a period of three years following the opening of my business. _____
- In an effort to assist the Selection Committee with evaluating my ability to obtain potential business credit including the lease or purchase of a facility, supplies or inventory, I understand that I am required to share any potential issues that may be obstacles to my success and that I may be required to provide my numerical credit score.

- I have read and understand all of the *Award Guidelines*.
 - Generally, legitimate business expenses that assist in starting or expanding business are appropriate uses of award money. This may include, for example:
 - Purchase of equipment, supplies, tools, or vehicle (if necessary for the business or integral part of the business plan);
 - Rent and utilities for the location in which the business will located (*in-kind only*);
 - Accounting or human resources consulting
 - Award amounts are typically not more than \$10,000 per business (total of cash and in-kind).
 - Funding from the Tobacco Region Revitalization Commission would be used to match local awards in Startup and Grow MHC which serve, at a minimum, regional markets such as small batch productions, technology, healthcare, construction trades and added-value agricultural projects versus service industries focused on local markets. On an individual basis, a business may be considered if there is sufficient data to support that significant leakage outside of our community exists for that business's product(s).
 - Complete at least 2 of the five workshops/classes offered by Longwood or any SBDC to enhance your skills. Provide C-PEG's office with a copy of your certificate of completion.
 - Attend at least 2 of the five monthly networking sessions with other StartUp and Grow Martinsville-Henry County program alumni. These events will invite local small business mentors to address relevant topics.
- These funds may <u>not</u> be used for salaries/wages, general overhead expenses, or included in general funds for the business. Use of the award money must be used for needs identified in the business plan.
